- ✧ NOTE: One of the Graduate Student Representatives from these states will need to serve as a co-chair on the committee.

All reps will have two-year terms, staggered by one year. This way, there is continuity and institutional memory on the committee from year to year.

- Graduate Student applicants must be currently enrolled in a graduate counselor education doctoral program.
- Application materials must be completed thoroughly and submitted by the deadline.
- Thoughtful responses need to be provided for the Statement of Interest and Professional Goals.

- Current Faculty sponsor supporting student's application. Please cc your sponsor when submitting your application.
- Agreement to participation as defined above.
